The project DKRZ_MIP_Pool_Analysis was established in 2019 to prepare the IS-ENES3 Transnational Access Service (TNA) activity which will start in 2020 and will support users in accessing the European CMIP6 data pools and related services at DKRZ, CEDA (UK), IPSL (France) and CMCC (Italy) in a coordinated way. The DKRZ data pool is supported as part of project 1017 (CMIP-DKRZ-DataPool).

In 2019 the project was mainly used in dissemination and outreach activities to IPCC working groups and other interested parties to discuss their needs with respect to data analysis of CMIP6 (and CORDEX). This attracted around 28 users (mainly from IPCC working groups) which are currently registered.

By now they mainly used interactive access to login nodes and required nearly no mistral batch compute resources. Allocation of batch compute time to users will start in 2020 as part of the IS-ENES3 service activity.
